A VITAL SERVICE

Sydney Ferries run:

- 547 services every day, going to
- 43 destinations, on
- 8 different routes, operating
- 20 hours a day,
- 7 days a week, and carry
- 14 million passengers a year

A STAR PERFORMER

Sydney's ferry service is one of the best performing public transport operations in the country.

And performance is improving further, thanks to the hard work of ferry staff.

Sydney Ferries has turned the corner and is now leading the way.

In 2008-09, Sydney Ferries were:

- ✓ **on time** 98.1% of services were on time
- ✓ **reliable** Just 0.5% of services were cancelled
- ✓ **popular** The number of passengers on normal services grew by 5.8%
- ✓ **friendly** Customer satisfaction reached 76.3%
